NOTICE INVITING TENDER

- 1.0 Additional General Manager, Ircon International Limited (IRCON in abbreviation), Siliguri-Islampur Road Project, Siliguri-734014 (W.B.), invites sealed tenders in two packet system on prescribed forms from bonafide firms/companies & contractors having requisite experience and financial capacity for execution of the following work:-

2.0 Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility of the applicants shall be assessed based on the "Essential Qualifying Criteria" and "Other Qualifying Criteria" as given in Annexure-A of the tender documents.

- 3.0 The tender documents can be obtained from 10.30 hours to 16.00 hours on all working days from **01.08.2009 to 18.8.2009** from the office of Siliguri-Islampur Road Project, Plot No.-609, College Para, Buri Balason, Lower Bagdogra, Siliguri-734014 (WB) on payment of **Rs. 2,000/-** per set (Non-refundable) in cash or Demand Draft/Pay order drawn in favour of Ircon International Limited payable at Siliguri towards the cost of one set of the tender documents for one package. Tender documents can also be obtained by post, for which an amount of Rs.500/- shall be charged extra. Ircon International Limited shall not be responsible for any postal delay in receiving the tender documents. The tender documents shall be sold only to the persons authorized in writing by the firm or company.

- 4.0 IRCON may issue addendum(s)/corrigendum(s) to the tender documents. In such case, the addendum(s)/corrigendum(s) shall be issued to the tenderers. Such addendum(s)/corrigendum(s) (if any) shall also be submitted, duly stamped and signed, alongwith the submission of the tenders. Any tender submitted without addendum(s)/corrigendum(s) (if any) shall be summarily rejected.
- 5.0 The tenderer shall prepare the tender documents in two packets.

Packet – I (Technical Bid)

Packet – I shall include: (i) Forwarding letter by the tenderer, (ii) Part – I of the Tender documents with all Pre-Qualification Documents as per annexure –IV & V of the tender documents.

The technical bid should also contain the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in a separate sealed cover.

Packet – II (Financial Bid)

Packet -II shall contain the Part – II of the Tender documents duly filled, signed & sealed.

The two packets shall be sealed in separate envelopes and shall be put in an outer envelop and shall contain the title as under:

The tenders should be deposited in the tender box at IRCON's office at address given above, before 12.00 hours of 21.08.2009. Tenders may also be received through Post / courier. Technical bid of the tenders shall be opened at 15:00 hours on 21.08.2009 in the presence of the tenderers or their authorised representatives intending to attend the opening.

- 6.0 Tender shall be submitted as per "Instructions to Tenderers" forming a part of the tender document.
- 7.0 Any tender received without Earnest Money in the form as specified in tender documents shall not be considered and shall be summarily rejected.

- 8.0 IRCON reserves the right to cancel the tenders before submission/opening of tenders, postpone the tender submission/opening date and to accept/reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof. IRCON's assessment of suitability shall be final and binding.
- 9.0 Tenderers may note that they are liable to be disqualified at any time during tendering process in case any of the information furnished by them is not found to be true. EMD of such tenderer shall be forfeited. The decision of IRCON in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 10.0 The validity of the offer shall be 180 days after the date of opening of the Technical Bid of the tender.
- 11.0 The transfer of tender documents purchased by one intending tenderer to another tenderer is not admissible. Tenderer can submit tenders only on the documents purchased from IRCON.

ANNEXURE – A

A. Essential Qualifying Criteria

1. The contractor should possess the experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years (ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited) which should be any one of the following:-
 - i) Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 30% of the estimated cost.
 - ii) Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.
 - iii) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 65% of the estimated cost.

Notes:

The similar works would be earthwork, construction of embankment, construction of road/ highway, bulk material handling requiring heavy equipments like excavators, tippers etc.

2. The average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.

Notes:

The financial turnover shall be judged from ITCC or Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account.

3. The Contractor should have positive net-worth. This will be judged from the audited Balance Sheet of the last financial year ending on a date not prior to 18 months from the due date of submission of the tender.
4. The contractor should submit performance certificates in reference to S.No.1 (minimum 3 nos., 2 nos. or 1 no. as the case may be) above from clients for having successfully completed similar works in the last 7 years.
5. There should not be any unsatisfactory performance Report of the Contractor from any source.
